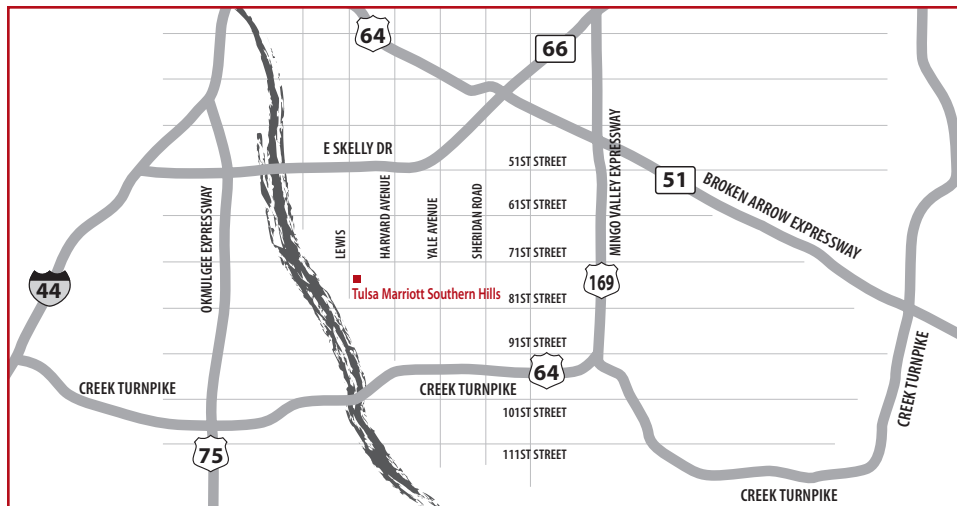

**Dominick M. Tursi**

Dominick opened The Gallery of Shorthand in 2010 in the lobby of the Federal Courthouse in Central Islip, NY, where he is employed as a federal official court reporter. The Gallery is an impressive museum of the evolution of shorthand that dates back to the shorthand developed by ancient Egyptian scribes in 3500 BC. In this session, Dominick will present shorthand's 5,000 year history using Ten Epochs of Shorthand, beginning with tracing the literacy of civilizations, China's creation of short forms of writing, the use of the first system of shorthand by Italy's Cicero, its abolition during the Dark Ages, its revival, the development by the Masters of Shorthand, its proliferation through Europe, the spread into America and the transition into machine shorthand.

The Boston Strangler terrorized the city of Boston, Massachusetts, from 1962 to 1964, when 13 women were brutally murdered. Albert DeSalvo confessed to all of those murders, but he was only tried for other crimes. Not every police official believed he was the Strangler. Was he? Join Dr. Aurelio, a reporter on the DeSalvo case, who will discuss many salient aspects regarding DeSalvo, Attorney F. Lee Bailey, and other principals (including a world-renowned psychic) in this strange case.

He will describe some 50 shorthand machines around the world concentrating on "The Important Three" in America, the growth of machines in the early 1900's, the development of the Stenograph Company and its importance to machine shorthand. He will compare machine keyboards from around the world, explain the reasons for creating the first computerized steno machine and present the background of paperless keyboard writers and the evolution of instant-translating machines.
